



4th Annual Marlborough Jumper Derby Saturday, March 21st, 2009

The Marlborough Jumper Derby is composed of a jumper style course with cross-country obstacles and elements with optimum time. Four height levels are offered, with two different courses per height. The first course (A) will be considered the warm-up course. The second course (B) will be the judged course.

Any attire, but must wear helmet, safety vest and proper footwear. Medical armbands recommended and available for sale at the event.

9 a.m.	12" - 18"	untimed, no bank.
11 a.m.	2' - 2'3"	325 meters per minute, bank optional
1 p.m.	2'3" - 2'7"	350 meters per minute, bank optional
3 p.m.	2'9" - 3'	375 meters per minute, bank required

Competitors may repeat either course as many times as desired. **This is a fundraiser for the Marlborough Horse Trials Schooling Field!**
